




IHPBA Membership Growth 2012 - 2016







Members at year end (2016 to date)




Membership Growth







2010 - 2016





Total Income (USD Thousands)




IHPBA Net Asset Trend

2007 - 2015








KWF Net Asset Trend



Transfer of HPB to Elsevier Oct 2015 - March 2016

- transfer of publisher from Wiley to Elsevier has gone well
- using the same third party submission system run by Thomson Reuters – Scholar One
- moving to the new Elsevier system to better support authors, reviewers and readers
- slight delay in publication for first few issues but production schedule now running well
- all HPB content now available on Elsevier's subscription platforms



Transfer of HPB to Elsevier Oct 2015 - March 2016

- manuscript submissions in 2015
 - 506
- turnaround time for first submission to decision
 - 24.8 days
- acceptance rate for 2015 32%






