Looking ahead, our goal is to reach 2,000 registered cases by January 2026, and we hope to continue expanding the registry with your valuable contributions.

First Digital IHPBA GBC Registry Meeting

Key discussion points included:

- Promoting a multidisciplinary approach, involving medical oncology to ensure inclusion of non-surgical patients.
- Organizing focus groups in high-impact regions to better understand local needs and priorities.
- Hosting a webinar for low- and middle-income countries in collaboration with local IHPBA chapters.
- Developing a platform for discussing future research initiatives and the potential setup of clinical trials.
